## **INFORMATION ON ENTRY VISAS TO GHANA**

Participants are informed that foreign nationals who wish to visit Ghana require entry visas. Please obtain a visa from the Ghana mission (Consular or Diplomatic representation) in your country of residence prior to departure.

For nationals of countries without Ghana missions, arrangements will be made to obtain visas upon arrival at the Kotoka International Airport in Accra-Ghana. This service will be at a fee of \$150. Visas will however be issued gratis to holders of Diplomatic and Service Passports or Diplomatic Laissez Passers.

To facilitate this process applicants are to forward scanned copies of their passport bio data page(s) to <u>info@africaain.org</u> and copied to; <u>joshuathompson@africaain.org</u>; <u>richardnartey@africaain.org</u> before 30<sup>th</sup> August 2016.

The following documents will also be required on arrival:-

a) Invitation letterb) Confirmation of conference registrationc) Return ticket

note that a valid certificate of immunisation against yellow is mandatory for travellers to Ghana.
